All members of the Ann Arbor Orchid Society can attend the club's Board Meetings. The schedule and the link to the zoom meeting are shown to the left.

The President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and one of the Director positions are open each May. All but the Secretary are term-limited this year. If you are interested in joining the Board, please let the Nominating Committee (Shane Ginnard and Dave Malmquist) know!

Elections for the AAOS Board will be during our regular meeting in May 2024. Only members in good standing as of the day of the election may vote.

The Board conducts routine business of the Society. The voting members of the Board consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Past President and two Directors.

Chairpersons of committees are appointed (rather than elected) and are nonvoting members of the Board.

A brief description of the responsibilities of each voting Board member is as follows:

- <u>President</u>: Sets the schedule and agenda for Board meetings, runs the general meetings.
- <u>Vice President</u>: Fills in for the President when the President isn't available.
- <u>Secretary</u>: Takes minutes of Board meetings. Conducts an election of a temporary meeting chairperson if both the President and Vice President aren't available.
- <u>Treasurer</u>: Handles the finances of the Society. Files all the taxes and other required documents with the State of Michigan and with the IRS.
- <u>Past President & Directors</u>: Assist the other members of the Board with decision making and conducting the routine business of the Society.
