

The Ann Arbor Orchid Society will have a display at the Grand Valley Orchid Show at the end of this month.


Please loan an in bloom plant for our display so we can show off our fabulous group!

Food Coordinator	Friday dinner through Sunday lunch	Ensures there is sufficient food and drink for show workers, vendors, judges, and clerks.
Kitchen Volunteers	2 hour shifts	Ensure the food and drink are set up and cleaned up as needed for their shift
Clerk Coordinator		Recruits clerks and informs them of their duties; ensures that judges and clerks have name tags, pens, clipboards, aprons, maps, and show schedules Saturday morning for judging
Clerks	Saturday morning	Help with spotting plants to be judged and with recording judges' decisions and distributing ribbons and trophies.
Auditorium Set-Up	Friday morning, 2 hour shifts	Move tables and chairs and mark off display areas for each exhibitor according to the Auditorium map.
Work on AAOS Display	Friday afternoon, 2 hour shifts	Set up AAOS display
Assist Vendors with Unloading their Vans	Friday afternoon, 2 hour shifts	Assist Vendors with Unloading their Vans

Set up Folders for Judging	Friday evening at Vivian's house
